A ONCE OUTDATED AND AWKWARD KITCHEN WAS RE-IMAGINED BY SAN DIEGO-BASED DESIGN-BUILD FIRM JACKSON DESIGN AND REMODELING

in the style of East Coast colonial, while taking advantage of the home's breathtaking California coastal views.

To better capture the spectacular vantage, the kitchen space was shifted and the windows were framed with authentic casings. In addition to the large windows, light in the space was maximized with pendant and recessed lighting, and light-colored cabinetry and tile work.

Peninsulas were added for more storage and functionality in a room with limited wall space.

Although the look evokes a bygone era, the kitchen is outfitted with modern appliances by Thermador, Wolf, Bosch, and Samsung.

NATURAL MATERIALS

Wood plays a starring role here. The floors are mahogany, the soapstone countertops are contrasted with the island's rich-grained wood surface, and the custom cabinetry is maple with a painted alabaster finish.
